

Action Taken Report of Feedback from Students, Alumni and Parents

The IQAC has collected the feedback from three different stakeholders viz. Students, alumni and parents of H.C.D.G College for the session 2020-21 using structured questionnaires and analysed systematically. The critical analysis of all feedback reports has documented the following major areas of institutional development-

- increasing the number of books in the college library.
- using more ICT tools in the classroom teaching.
- introduction of additional stream like Science, Commerce along with new subjects like sociology.
- opening of more skill based courses.

The institution in association with IQAC has been taking some efforts in resolving all those issues. A total amount of Rs 19000 books have been added to college library this year. This amount is low as the admission fees of the students have not been reimbursed by Assam government as per Fee Waiver Scheme in time. Regarding the use of ICT tools all the teachers are directed to use PPT presentation of the classes wherever possible and use different medium of teaching and learning like Google Classroom, Zoom, Google Meet etc. All the teachers have used all these tools for teaching and learning during the Covid-19 pandemic when offline teaching was discontinued. Again respective authorities are communicated in written to introduce new courses in the college but no official confirmation has been received from their end till now. So, whenever the permission is granted it will take immediate action in this context. Regarding the introduction of new skill based courses in this college we have been analyzing the feasibility of opening self-sustained courses on computer application, food processing, yoga and meditation etc. After detailed analysis of feasibility status, course plan and course of action it is anticipated to take proper action from the next academic year.

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
